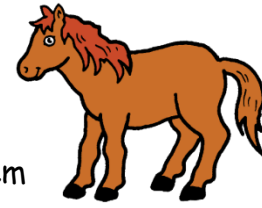
Home and School Association's Third Annual Pony Plop
